- ___ Outdoor Sports **DRESS WARM!** Assist with set-up/tear down of venue, and any other needs. Be flexible.
- ___ Office Help Assist with clerical, mailings, answer phones, and other duties needed, flexible Schedules.
- ___ Ice Carving Assistants **DRESS WARM!** Monitoring of people's choice balloting providing carver's with food/drinks during carving. Assist with judging (helping cover Signage that displays carver name) crowd control
Assist Carvers with set-up/tear down of venue, trash removal, Award and Sculpture Signage, and any other needs. You will rotate with your fellow volunteers to warm up, but for the most part, you will be outside.
NOTE: Please make sure to check back before shift to be sure shift is not canceled due to weather conditions.
- ___ Snow Stompers **Dress for the weather!** You'll be working outside and with snow. You will rotate with your fellow volunteers to warm up, but for the most part, you will be outside. Volunteers should be 12 years of age and older.
- ___ Rice Park Greeters **DRESS WARM!** Greeting guests, answering questions pertaining to Winter Carnival and other events. Handing out general information.

___	Coronation	Coat Check Attendants, Greeters (Assist guests to tables), Changing Room Monitors (watching personal items), Production Assistants (assisting with Coronation show).
___	Merchandise	Assist with the selling of Carnival Merchandise. Assist with restocking and Minimal handling of cash. Assist with set up/breakdown.
___	Parades	DRESS WARM for the weather! Parade Assembly (These persons will help Set up the parade and assist in helping getting parade unit to there proper. Line up spot. The Division coordinators will assign them their position. Banner Carriers, Street Monitors, Volunteer Check-in, Snowflake/V's Carriers, Dispersal (assist the coordinator in getting all the units In dispersal to pack up there units and leave the area.)
___	Family Days	assist with family day activities. Assist on clean-up. Basic information About festival, help monitor/give directions to Guests
___	Kids Day	Assist with indoor and outdoor activities, i.e., Sled parade, games, puzzles, etc.
___	Volunteer Central	These volunteers will be assisting other volunteers to check in, direct them To their locations and keep volunteer area tidy and stocked with Appropriate items (snacks, etc.). Serve as an information resource for Volunteer questions (Volunteers will also be taking turns answering Questions from the general public on the Hotline. You may want to bring a Book with them in case things are slow.
___	“Go To List”	Flexibility is a MUST! Able to come and assist any time for additional Needs not listed.
